## Notice for the request of 'Expression of Interest for "Continuing Professional Development (CPD) - Training Providers"

The Pharmacy Council is the professional regulatory body established by the Pharmacy Act, Cap 311 to regulate standards and practice of pharmacists, pharmaceutical technicians and pharmaceutical assistants.

*Regulation 46 of the Registration of Persons GN. No 332 of 2005* require every registered person to attend a Continuing Professional Development program in order to continue to practice pharmacy.

The Pharmacy Council (PC) is coordinating CPD programs for the year 2020/2021 through engaging competent providers for the training as per the requirement of the Council.

As part of the initial training, the PC invites Expression of Interest (EoI) from local private organizations and training institutions that may wish to provide such **training services**. The topics that will be considered in 2020/2021 are as follows:

- a) Developing pharmacist's leadership and management skills.
- b) Writing a research article for publication.
- c) <u>Communication skills in pharmacy practice.</u>
- d) <u>Use of pharmacy references for better therapeutic outcome.</u>

Organizations or institutions or individuals who may wish to provide one or more of the above mentioned topics shall apply for this assignment and **must** have the following:

- 1. Certified as a company, institution or other legal entity from the relevant institutions to undertake such training;
- 2. A track record of conducting such training. The experience may be as a team in an organization, or with respect to the specific individual within an organization who will conduct the training;
- 3. Fluent in both English and Swahili on the part of the trainer/s;

The (EoI) should include covering letter, teaching materials for selected topic (s), license/registration certificate, related experiences, company/organization profile and CV of the trainer/s.
