1. Examination fee is TZS. 160,000/= for new applicants; and TZS. 50,000/= for each examination for re-sitters. In the application process, a control number for payment will automatically be generated.
2. Applicants are required to upload **certified copies** of following documents:
  - (a) **For Intern Pharmacists;**  
Birth certificate, O-Level certificate, A-Level certificate, award certificate in pharmaceutical sciences, full academic transcript, certificate of recognition from TCU and evidence of internship completion.
  - (b) **For Pharmaceutical Technicians, Assistants and Pharmaceutical Dispensers;**  
Birth certificate, O-Level certificate, award certificate in pharmaceutical sciences and full academic transcript.

4. All applications must be completed, paid for and submitted by midnight (12.00am) on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2022.
