RESULTS FOR PRE-REGISTRATION AND PROFESSIONAL EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED IN MARCH, 2026 AND SCHEDULE FOR UPCOMING EXAMINATIONS

DODOMA: 10th April, 2026

The Council wishes to inform all candidates who sat for the Pre-registration and Professional Examinations in March, 2026 that, the results have been released and are available through each candidate's personal account in PCMIS. Candidates are required to access their results via their individual accounts.

All candidates are required to note the following;

1. Candidates who have successfully passed the examinations are required to submit an online application for registration, enrolment, or enlistment through their respective personal accounts in PCMIS;
2. All intern pharmacists are required to return their Internship Logbooks to the Pharmacy Council Offices;
3. Induction training for newly registered pharmacists shall be conducted on 30th April, 2026. Therefore, applications for registration shall be submitted from 11th April, 2026 to 16th April, 2026;
4. Candidates who have one or two supplementary examinations shall be required to pass the examination(s) within two years from the first sitting;
5. Candidates who wish to re-sit the failed examinations are required to apply for the next examinations scheduled from 22nd to 24th July, 2026 through their personal accounts in PCMIS via the link: <https://www.pc.go.tz/professional-exams-apps/>. The application window shall be open from 20th April, 2026 to 29th May, 2026;
6. Candidates who failed all three (3) examinations and wish to re-sit are required to apply after a period of six months from the date of the previous sitting;
7. Examination contents and other relevant conditions can be found in the Guidelines for Conducting Pre-Registration and Professional Examinations of 2019, available at the following link: <https://www.pc.go.tz/professional-Examinations-Contents/>;
8. Examination fee is TZS. 160,000/= for new applicants; and TZS. 50,000/= for each examination for re-sitters;

9. Candidates who wish to postpone sitting for examinations after submitting their application are required to submit a notice to the Pharmacy Council's Offices at least two weeks before the scheduled date of the examination.

10. Applicants are required to upload **certified copies** of the following documents:

(a) **For Intern Pharmacists;**

Identity Card, Birth certificate, O-Level certificate, A-Level Certificate/Diploma certificate, Certificate from recognized University or/and Certificate of Recognition from TCU and evidence of internship completion.

(b) **For Pharmaceutical Technicians, Assistants and Pharmaceutical Dispensers;**

Identity card, Birth Certificate, O-Level certificate, award certificate in pharmaceutical sciences and full academic transcript.

NOTE: Any application made without appropriate attachments **SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
