INTERNSHIP TRAINING APPLICATION FOR JUNE 2026 INTAKE

DODOMA: 11th May, 2026

1. The Pharmacy Council under the Ministry of Health is inviting pharmacy graduates who have completed a degree training of not less than four (04) years to apply for Internship training for June 2026 intake. The Internship program is a mandatory training and an additional pre-requisite for a graduate prior registration as a pharmacist in accordance to Section 17 (1) of the Pharmacy Act, [Cap 311 R.E 2023] and Regulation No. 5(1) of "The Pharmacy (Registration, Enrolment and Enlisting of Persons) Regulations, G.N No.332 of 2005". This training must be taken in an uninterrupted period of 12 months.
2. From the 12th May, 2026 qualified graduates may register and apply online through the link: <https://www.pc.go.tz/internship-apps/>. Applications should be accompanied with payment of provisional registration fee amounting TZS. 175,000/=. Please note that, the Control Number for payment will be provided to eligible graduates after scrutinization of the applications.
3. Applicants shall be required to have the following scanned colored documents prior application:
 - i. Certified copy of Secondary Education Examination Certificate;
 - ii. Certified copy of Advanced Secondary Education Examination Certificate or Certified copy of Diploma of Pharmaceutical Sciences Certificate;
 - iii. Certified copy of Bachelor of pharmacy degree certificate and full transcript of academic records;
 - iv. Certified copy of Birth certificate;
 - v. For applicants who studied bachelor of pharmacy or secondary education abroad shall have to attach a certified copy of recognition certificate from TCU and certified copy of equivalent certificates from NECTA respectively;
 - vi. One passport size photograph with blue background; and
 - vii. NIDA identification card / number.

4. The deadline for submission of application shall be on **Thursday 14th May, 2026** at 11:59 pm.
